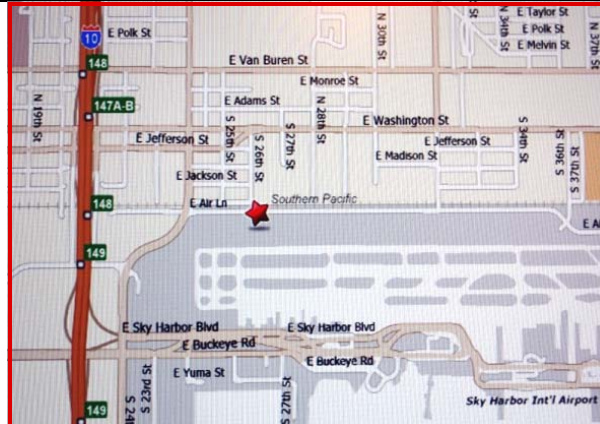
Last call for RSVP on social event of the year!
